In addition, we would like to receive any and all records associated with filed permissions for interlocking directorates at the NAACP and Goldman Sachs, specific to Mr. Rose (<a href="https://naacp.org/people/peter-rose">https://naacp.org/people/peter-rose</a>) and Mr. Ogunlesi (<a href="https://www.goldmansachs.com/about-us/people-and-leadership/leadership/board-of-directors/adebayo-o-ogunlesi.html">https://www.goldmansachs.com/about-us/people-and-leadership/leadership/board-of-directors/adebayo-o-ogunlesi.html</a>).

Finally, we would like to receive any and all records related to NY-DFS monitoring of Goldman Sachs' minority scholarship fund support in Africa (and how any non-approved interlocking directorates may be engaged in AML violations).

To the extent that your request is reasonably described, please be advised that the New York State Division of Human Rights does not have any records in its possession responsive to your FOIL request.

Any person denied access to a requested record may, within thirty (30) days of the denial, appeal the denial in writing by mail or fax to Caroline J. Downey, General Counsel, N.Y.S. Division of Human Rights, One Fordham Plaza, 4th Floor, Bronx, New York 10458.
